QUARTERLY MEETING

The first quarterly meeting of the Chilton County Historical Society will be held at the Chilton/Clanton Public Library Conference Room. Special guest speaker for this meeting will be Mr. Paul Burks of Wilsonville, Al. The subject of the presentation will be the inside story about finding an original copy of the Declaration of Independence. Mr. Burks will then detail all of the efforts involved in attempting to authenticate or not this apparently valuable document. It promises to be one of the most interesting programs ever available to the Society. Meeting will start promptly at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, the 10th of January, 1993.

CV CENSUS

In the course of our search to establish the Confederate service of some of the men included in our CSA listing, mentioned so often previously, we were pleasantly surprised to locate another source of information. Service records on microfilm at the Alabama State Archives referred in some cases to the 1921 Confederate Veteran Census. Pursuit of this source was taken to one of the archivists on duty and the following reference numbers were offered. For infantry regiments the major portion are contained in reference number SG 4347. SG 4348 contains the remaining infantry regiments and

the Cavalry regiments. Artillery and other organizations are in SG 4349. These census records are recorded on front and back of 8 1/2 by 14 (legal size) sheets and contain a great amount of pertinent information. Records are maintained alphabetically within each regiment so that locating a particular veteran is quite straightforward.

Unfortunately, the record does not show the wife's name, only her age and the date of the marriage. Even these bits of information are missing whenever the veteran is a widower. However, for all those veterans who were still living in 1921, and who received the questionnaire, it is a priceless find. We encourage our members to take advantage of this source if they have not previously found them.

NP EXTRACT

From The Banner, 6 February 1902 we have extracted the following article pertaining to one of the

county's prominent citizens whose death occurred in a particularly interesting set of circumstances. "Mr. J.C. Laporte was over from Wetumka Thursday and gave the regrettable news of the death of Mr. O.M. Mastin near Wetumka last Monday of acute pneumonia, after only one day's sickness. He had been feeble from some days but did not take to his bed until Sunday, when his sickness became very acute and he died the next day. Mr. Mastin was white Creek by blood and was a prominent, useful man of intelligence and culture. He was a native of Alabama, where he was a man of prominence, having been a member of the Alabama legislature and the incumbent of various offices of honor and trust. From Alabama he came to the Creek nation and established his rights as a member of the tribe in 1895, settling near the mission ford on the North fork, where he has since resided, a prosperous and industrious farmer. He leaves a wife, an adopted son and a sister, Mrs. J.C. Laporte.-Holdenville (I.T.) Times."

QUARTERLY MEETING

The quarterly meeting of the Chilton County Historical Society will be held at Shoney's on the 11th of July 1993 and will begin at 2:00 p.m. This will be an update and business meeting as no program has been scheduled.

CSA LISTING

The list is still growing and appears to be an unending project. Since it may never be completed it seems fair to publish that portion of the listing which is relatively accurate and complete. With that in mind we felt it necessary to establish a limiting date for input and updating. Consequently, all material to be added to the listing after 31 August will be apportioned to a listing for future publication. The list currently contains 1242 names but is to be updated again in the next few days which will probably increase the number of those found to about 1250. It appears that about 100 of those in the list will require more research and therefore will be carried forward to the next listing. Hence, the list to be published will in all likelihood approximately of 1150 names. It will be an interesting publication and will be more than adequately referenced for verification.

CLANTON'S BRIGADE

That our members may know more about this particular brigade organized by none other than James Holt Clanton, who was promoted to Brigadier General in March of 1863, we reproduce here the units and officers that served in this brigade. The integrity of the brigade was never allowed and so it never served all together in any one battle. However, it being formed by the man for whom the county seat is named deserves recognition. Still many of the units served in some awesome battles. The 61st Infantry, for instance, served at the siege of Petersburg and was at

Appamattox when the Confederate Army surrendered. Most of the following information has been transcribed from Brewer's Alabama: Her History, Resources War Record and Public Men from 1540 to 1872.
